The Program.

The embodiment of ANCOR's 40th anniversary commitment to "*Celebrating the Past ~ Shaping the Future*" is the ANCOR Foundation Legacy Leaders Circle, which celebrates the accomplishments of the men and women who have paved the way to life in community settings for people with disabilities. These visionary leaders have made meaningful community participation a reality for the nearly 500,000 Americans with disabilities ANCOR providers support.

The ANCOR Foundation Legacy Leaders Circle honors our finest and most influential leaders, while creating an endowment to fund the development of future leaders in our field.

The Inaugural class will be inducted into the Circle on September 13, 2010 at ANCOR's 40th Anniversary Party.

Eligibility.

Nominees for this award will have distinguished themselves in one or more of the following ways:

- Active, long-term ANCOR membership (minimum of seven years)
- Service as chair, co-chair or committee member within ANCOR
- Participation in ANCOR or ANCOR Foundation governance structure (Board of Directors, Board of Representatives, other)
- Other association activity

Levels of Support.

The foundation recommends a minimum contribution of \$1,000 to accompany each nomination. Half of that amount will go to immediate leadership development needs; the remaining half will be placed in trust to create a permanent legacy to fund future leadership development.

Additional recognition is available at the \$5,000 level.

Examples of activities supported with these contributions:

- Support for an emerging leader to attend an ANCOR conference
- Partial scholarship to the Leadership Institute at the University of Delaware
- Networking opportunities for emerging leaders across the country

Nominations.

Nominations will be accepted from a variety of sources, including agency boards of directors, family members and colleagues.

A selection committee has been established to review nominations. For approved nominations, the nominator must supply the \$1,000 contribution, prior to induction.

The honoree will receive:

- Commemorative Plaque

- Recognition at ANCOR's 40th Anniversary Party at the National Portrait Gallery on Monday, September 13, 2010 (includes admission for honoree and 1 guest)
- Recognition in the official ANCOR Foundation Legacy Leaders recognition booklet

The deadline for nominations for 2010 Legacy Leaders class is July 31, 2010.

In the future, nominations will be accepted throughout the year and the ANCOR Foundation will recognize Legacy Leaders annually.
