* Section 5001(f) of ARRA provides a set of special rules regarding States maintaining their eligibility requirements (MOE) in order to qualify for the increased FMAP for Medicaid and, based on preliminary analysis, Title IV-E; it also provides States which fail to satisfy the MOE an opportunity to reinstate their eligibility standards, methodologies, and procedures by July 1, 2009 and become eligible, should they wish to do so, for the increased FMAP. CMS has clearly determined 4 States (NC, SC, and VA) fail to qualify for the increased FMAP at this time.
